MAKING A DIFFERENCE

Foyle Hospice is situated on the banks of the River Foyle and was officially opened on the 21st of June 1991. A modern specialist palliative care unit with 12 in-patient beds the hospice has helped many patients and their families cope with the physical and emotional reality of life-threatening illnesses.

All care is free of charge

• In-Patient Care

Patients and their families are cared for in the Hospice by a dedicated team of doctors, nurses, other healthcare professionals and volunteers. Patients may be admitted for respite care for pain or symptom control with a view to being discharged home. Patients are also admitted for specialist care and support in the terminal phase of their illness.

• Community Palliative Care

Many patients wish to remain in their own homes, close to family and loved ones. To ensure this happens the Community Palliative Care team work closely with GPs and District Nurses offering support and advice to ensure patients receive the best quality of care available.

• Day Therapy

The Day Therapy Unit provides an informal and relaxed atmosphere for patients. A visit to the unit offers patients a change of surroundings and a chance to make new friends. Furthermore carers at home will benefit from the opportunity to have a short break from looking after an ill friend or relative.

• Bereavement Support

Bereavement Support is an important element of hospice care. Support is available to relatives and friends through regular bereavement meetings. Offering a safe, secure and comfortable environment people can express their feelings relating to their experience of loss.

• Education

Ongoing education programmes play an important role in extending the knowledge of Hospice care to other health professionals.
